On 3rd April, we announced that Fr Robert Davoren SJ would be completing his eleven years at Saint Ignatius' College Adelaide at the end of this year to take up a new ministry involving leadership and finance at a Province level. That letter expressed our gratitude for Fr Davoren's service at Saint Ignatius', which included seven years as Headmaster and four years as Rector and CEO, and noted that next year, the leadership model would change to one in which there would be a lay Principal and a Jesuit Rector.

We are now happy to announce that, from the start of 2018, Fr Peter Hosking SJ will be the new Rector at Saint Ignatius'. Fr Hosking is an old Ignatian who is currently serving as Rector at St Aloysius' College in Sydney. Before this, he was involved in a range of ministries across the Province and overseas, giving him a wealth of experience which he will contribute to his role at Saint Ignatius'.

Meanwhile the process of selection of the new lay Principal for Saint Ignatius' is well under way and it is hoped that an appointment can be announced before too long. Fr Hosking has accompanied the first lay Principal at St Aloysius' and is well placed to undertake this task at Saint Ignatius'. In the meantime, please join us in praying for God's continued blessings on Fr Davoren in this final year at the College, and on Fr Hosking as he finishes up in Sydney and prepares to return to his hometown. In commending them to your prayers, we thank you for your ongoing support for the Saint Ignatius' community.
